ORDINANCE 2019- 9

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF MT. ZION CODE OF ORDINANCES TITLE XIII: GENERAL PROVISIONS BY ADDING SECTION 130.06 FIGHTING AND BY AMENDING SECTION 130.99 PENALTY

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of each municipality may prevent fighting and all other disorderly conduct 65 ILCS 5/11-5-3; and

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs, and to review, interpret and amend its ordinances, rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mt. Zion Board of Trustees believes that the Village of Mt. Zion should modify, update and amend its ordinances to more closely comport with current Illinois State laws;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. ZION, MACON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Chapter 130 - General Provisions shall be amended to add the following:

SECTION 130.06 FIGHTING

SECTION 1: DEFINITIONS

- A. **Fight**: an encounter involving unwanted or provoking physical contact between two or more persons
- B. **Assault**: A person commits an assault when, without lawful authority, he or she knowingly engages in conduct which places another in reasonable apprehension of receiving a battery
- C. **Battery**: A person commits battery if he or she knowingly without legal justification by any means:
 - 1) Causes bodily harm to an individual; or
 - 2) Makes physical contact of an insulting or provoking nature with an individual.

SECTION 2: It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly and without legal justification by any means to:

- A. Start a fight or engage in a fight; or
- B. To commit an assault or battery anywhere within the Village of Mt. Zion corporate limits.

SECTION 3: Section 130.99 Penalty Shall be Amended to Read as Follows:

(E) First Offense

1-10 Days

11-15 Days

Second Offense (within 3 years)

1-10 Days

1-15 Days

\$300.00

\$350.00

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
