**VILLAGE OF MT. ZION, ILLINOIS
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 32: TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES
OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. ZION CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, the Village of Mt. Zion Board of Trustees have determined that this amendment is necessary and advantageous and supports the public health, welfare, safety, and morals of the public and have authorized the same by vote of the Village Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Mt. Zion, Illinois, in the County of Macon, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The preliminary paragraphs set forth above are incorporated herein as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Amendment to Ordinance. Chapter 32: Traffic and Vehicles of the Mt. Zion Code of Ordinances is hereby amended in accordance with the changes depicted in Exhibit A which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication according to law.





1. **EXHIBIT A.** Village of Mt. Zion Code of Ordinances Sec. 32-102. – Parking restrictions on certain streets.

Sec. 32-102. – Parking restrictions on certain streets

(a) It shall be unlawful for any motor vehicle to park or stand on portions of the following streets where official signs prohibit parking:

(1) Green Valley Drive.

(b) Official signs prohibiting parking which were posted prior to the effective date of this Section shall remain in full force and effect.
